Honorary Lifetime members are listed in the association directory, receive individual invitations to all MIAS functions and mailings and are honored guests at the MIAS annual banquet. Eligible nominees must be permanently retired from the industry and have served a minimum of 15 years in the MIAS community as a member in good standing.

Nomination Guidelines

Nominations must be received no later than November 1st.

Nominations must include a written statement setting forth why the nominee should be considered for Honorary Lifetime Membership.

The Board retains sole power to decide whether Honorary Lifetime award will be made.

Qualifications:

A person is only eligible for Honorary Lifetime Membership in MIAS if s/he has provided distinguished service to the Northwest's Marine Insurance community. Minimum qualifications for a successful nominee include:

1. Has retired or is retiring - permanently - from the industry.
2. Has spent a minimum of 15 years employment in the Northwest's Marine Insurance community.
3. Will have worked for the betterment of the Association by performing committee work, instruction of continuing education classes, or planning &/or development of educational or social events, etc.
4. Will have helped other people in the Marine Insurance community grow & develop professionally (mentoring)

No person will be eligible for Honorary Lifetime Membership if that person has been convicted of a felony, or if that person has had his or her professional license(s) suspended or revoked.
